

EDEXCEL LEVEL 3 APPRENTICESHIP IN HEALTH AND SOCIAL CARE (QCF 92 CREDITS)

Through completion of this apprenticeship learners will gain broad-base training in their chosen occupational area with a broad knowledge base of the sector as a whole, work experience that leads to competency in the work place and transferable skills. Learners will undertake the following qualifications to complete the apprenticeship framework;

- > Key Skills in Mathematics level 2 (QCF 5 Credits)
- > Level 3 Diploma in Health & Social Care (Adults) (QCF 58 Credits)
- > Level 3 Certificate in Preparing to Work in Adult Social Care (QCF 21 Credits)
- > Employer Rights and Responsibilities (QCF 3 Credits)



Who is this course suitable for?

This is the sole apprenticeship Framework for people employed in delivering adult social care in England. It provides a suitable way to meet the development and qualification needs of a variety of roles and job titles, including care officers, care supervisors, senior care workers, community support and outreach development workers, personal assistants, social services officers, domiciliary care workers and personal assistants. As well as being suitable for existing staff, this framework gives apprentices extensive opportunities to gain employment in the social care sector as well as in some health care roles.

In the health sector this framework is suitable for healthcare assistants or clinical support workers. This framework supports the broad vision of the sector to develop an increasingly skilled flexible and effective workforce & addresses specific outcomes of the Skills for Health Sector Skills assessment 2011

Do I need any experience?

No experience is necessary however candidates will need to be employed within the care sector as the Diploma is partially competency based. All candidates must meet the required standards.

How is the qualification delivered?

This programme is delivered part distance learning and part class room based.

What will I gain from this course?
