

LEVEL TWO CERTIFICATE IN HEALTH AND SAFETY AT WORK (QCF 13 CREDITS)

The qualification will enable candidates to improve their current knowledge of Health and Safety, by introducing candidates to the various Health and Safety UK and European Acts and legislation. Candidates will gain an understanding of the risks and hazards that can exist within the working environment and the Health and Safety at Work Act 1974. The programme consists of three units and will consist of a Day Workshop at one of our College venues.

All candidates who have already completed at least one of the main Redundancy Programme Courses. All candidates who wish to increase their knowledge and Health and Safety with a view to accessing employment and or progressing to further and/or higher programmes of study in this sector.
