# SCHOOL LIAISON OFFICERS How can our team support you?

Type of offering:	Further details:
Assemblies	Assemblies are typically 10 to 20 minutes in length, usually delivered to one year group of students.
Workshops	Workshops are typically 45 to 60 minutes long, usually delivered to one class. Workshops can be delivered in a carousel, where we would deliver a number of workshops in one day to multiple groups of students.
Application Workshops	Application Workshops are a drop in session for students who need help making an application to college. These can fit around the typical school timetable, and would usually take one lesson space.
Careers Fairs/ Post 16 Events/ Higher Education Fairs/ Options Evenings	These events would usually be arranged by the school, where they would invite a number of organisations to participate in a market style set up. We would bring prospectuses and merchandise to engage and advise students about their future.
Campus Tours	Campus Tours last approximately 45 minutes with a maximum of 15 students. During the tour, your SLO will show you the facilities of your chosen college and answer your students questions.
Lunchtime Drop Ins	A lunchtime drop in consists of a table set up in the lunch hall. The SLO would be on hand to answer any questions that students might have about college. This is a useful way to engage with students in a short period of time, and to give out prospectuses and advise on Post 16 Options.
